For as long as I can remember, my work was completely abstract and primarily three-dimensional; now, in his absence, the focus is two-dimensional, and a menagerie of characters have entered my paintings.

The transition was gradual. Abstract constructions, drawings, and paintings gradually made way to strictly two-dimensional pieces. Eventually, characters began elbowing their way in. I was as surprised as anyone, but I welcome them and the new life they have generated in my studio.
